1.0 Introduction

1.1 Emergency contraception, or post-coital contraception, refers to methods of contraception that can be used to prevent pregnancy in the first few days after intercourse. It is intended for emergency use following unprotected intercourse, contraceptive failure or misuse (such as forgotten pills or torn condoms). Emergency contraception is effective only in the first few days following intercourse before the ovum is released from the ovary and before the sperm fertilizes the ovum. Any woman of reproductive age may need emergency contraception at some point to avoid an unwanted pregnancy. This public health agreement covers the provision of Levonorgestrel and Ulipristal acetate

3.0 Aims and intended service outcomes

- 3.1 To increase the knowledge, especially among young people, of the availability of emergency contraception and contraception from pharmacies.
- 3.2 To improve access to emergency contraception and sexual health advice.
- 3.3 To increase the use of EC by women who have had unprotected sex and help contribute to a reduction in the number of unplanned pregnancies in the
