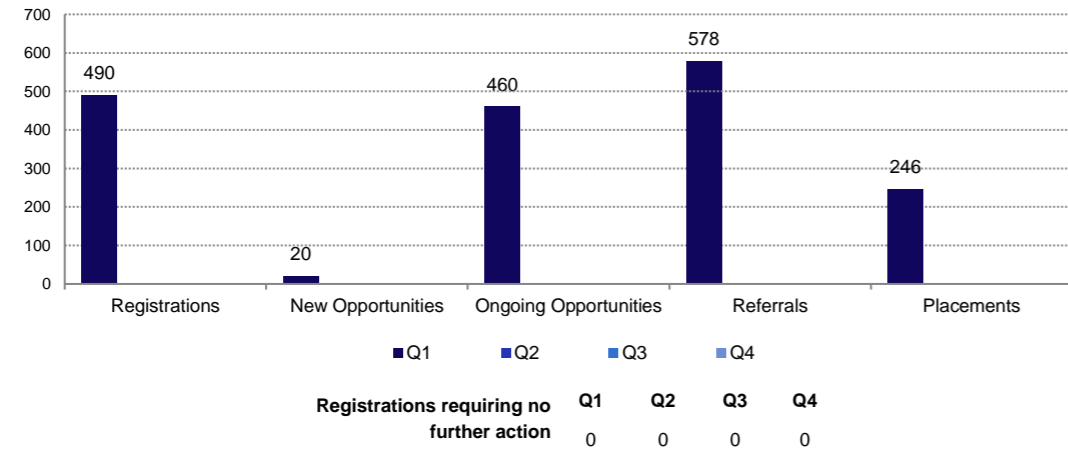


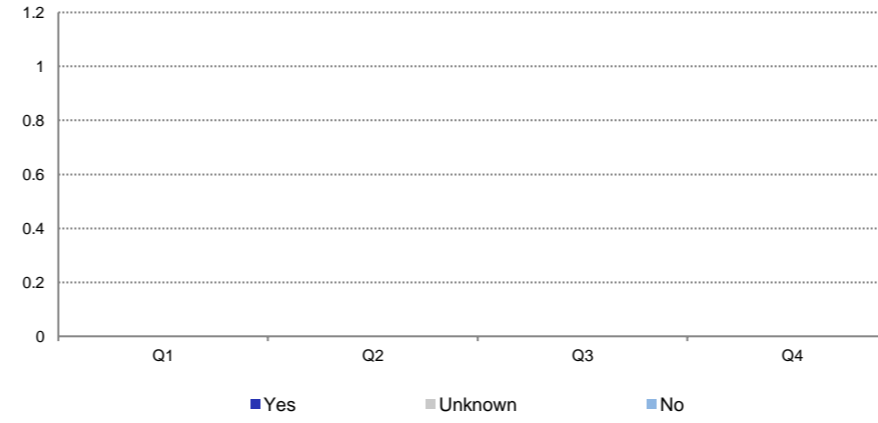

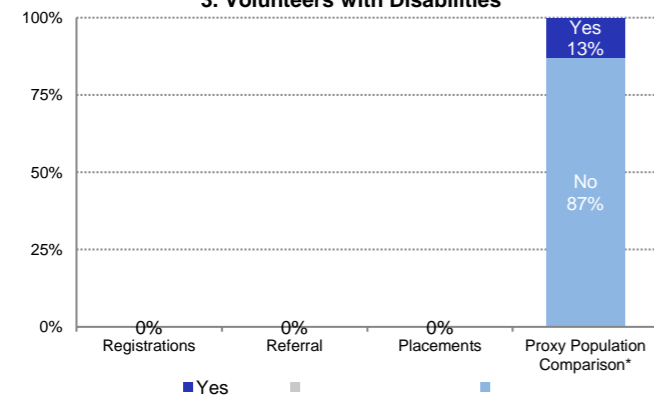


2. Volunteers still in place after 2 months

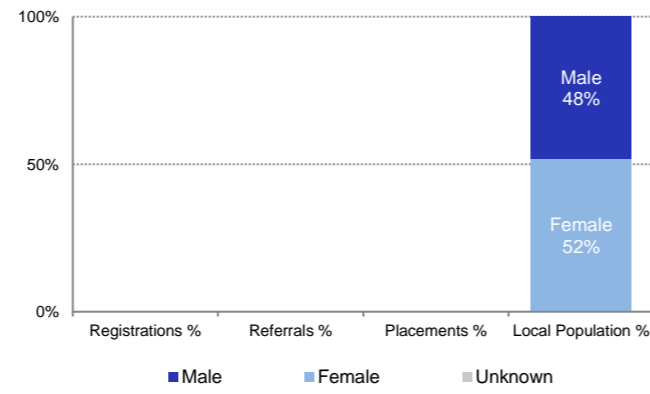

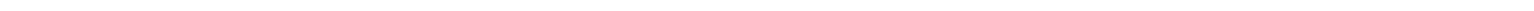
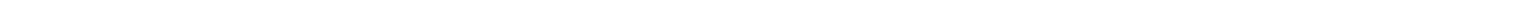
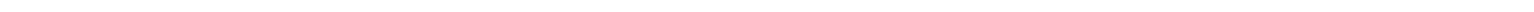
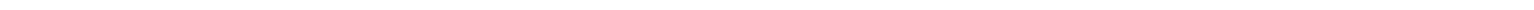
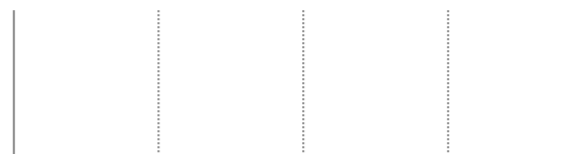
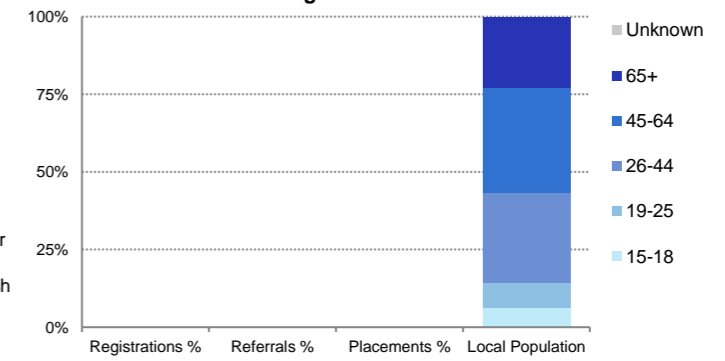
4. Gender of Volunteers
